

MAINSTAGE TECHNICAL RIDER

This technical rider lists specific technical requirements necessary for a quality concert by The Dancing Wheels Company. Recognizing the varied performance spaces available, this rider consists of 3 concert choices (Concerts A, B, and C) suitable for different size venues and technical capabilities. Please choose the concert which best suits your venue, then review and initial each line item. If any element necessary for your concert choice differs or is not available, please note differences in detail on the rider and contact Marissa Thomas, 216.432.0306 or touring@dancingwheels.org, who will assist you in negotiating changes with the Dancing Wheels Director.

All changes MUST be noted in the rider prior to signing.

All contracts and details related to the tour must be finalized one (1) month prior to the company's arrival.

Failure to meet requirements after the rider has been signed may result in the cancellation of the performance with full payment due.

CONCERT A

FACILITY/STAGE:

DANCING WHEELS is an integrated dance company comprised of professional dancers with and without disabilities (including numerous wheelchair dancers). The choreography presented by the company uses the full spectrum of the performance space. This encompasses extensive floor work and classical modern dance work that requires good traction for bare feet, dance shoes and fast, intricate wheeling.

IT IS THEREFORE IMPERATIVE THAT THE FLOOR BE PREPARED AS FOR ANY PROFESSIONAL DANCE COMPANY AS SPECIFIED BELOW TO ENSURE THE HIGHEST ARTISTIC QUALITY AND THE ABSOLUTE SAFETY OF OUR DANCERS.

Minimum stage size is 35' (wide) x 25" (deep) proscenium style. (The
audience must be seated to the front of the performance area only.)
4 wings on each side of the stage, masked with black. Wings must be
clear of cables, rugs, mats, etc. Wings must be at least 48" wide to
accommodate clear and safe passage of our wheelchair dancers, overlapping
entrances and exits, as well as lighting booms.
The floor must be professional style in black or gray to cover
performance area (Rosco, Marley, New Step, Harlequin, etc.) All seams must be
taped down by presenter with floor tape (not duct tape) before technical
rehearsal. The floor must be flat and free of pockets with no bumps, crevices
or other obvious impediments. (Please note that the floor panels must be laid
before company arrival and technical rehearsal).
Both on and off-stage areas must be swept and mopped prior to the
technical rehearsal. If necessary, it must be swept and mopped again prior to
the performance.
Light colored Cyc (wrinkle free).
Black border to mask overhead.
2 wheelchair accessible dressing rooms and bathrooms available near
off-stage and on-stage level with appropriate height mirrors and clothing racks.

LIGHTING:
Theatre specifications must be provided to DANCING WHEELS 3 months prior to performance. The company will then provide the presenter with a light plot 2 months prior to performance. The presenter must hang, cable and patch the light plot prior to the company's arrival. After the company arrives and prior to the technical rehearsal, 4 technicians, along with ladders or a lift must be provided by presenter to help focus the show.
The following are lighting requirements necessary for our lighting plot in the Concert A choice:
3 booms stage left and right – 6 Ellipsoidal on each boom16 pars or fresnels for backlight12 pars or fresnels for top light18 Ellipsoidal high sides (6 on each of 3 electric's)12 Ellipsoidal front of house16 gobo Ellipsoidal12 Specials (Ellips, Frens, and Pars)3 color Cyc lightingControl to record and playback cues

Two hand-held microphones on stands are to be placed downstage
left and right near proscenium (no podium). They must be cordless of have a
cord long enough to reach to the center stage.
2 stage monitors (one speaker stage left and one stage right with
separate controls from front of house).
Headsets for curtain operator, light operator, board operator and stage manager. All technical persons should be able to communicate with each
other during the technical rehearsal and performance.
